MODE OF SELECTION:

Selection shall be made on the basis of merit of prescribed educational qualification i.e. Middle/Matric as the case may be followed by evaluation. Percentage of marks obtained in Middle/Matric will be calculated out of 85. For example, a candidate getting 50% marks will be given 42.5 marks. Evaluation of the remaining 15 marks will be done on the basis of parameters devised by Govt. of H.P. vide Department of Personnel's Notification No. Per (AP. B) B (15) - 5/ 2014 dated 17.04.2017. There will be no written examination and interview. The merit list will be prepared on the basis of particulars provided by the candidate in Online Application Form. Top candidates in merit in the ratio of 20 times of total posts in respect of any particular category will be called for evaluation of 15 marks. The final merit will be made on the basis of the marks obtained in prescribed educational qualification as per above criteria and the marks obtained in evaluation.

The candidate must provide correct information as sought through Online Application Form. Onus lies on the candidate that he or she has provided true & correct information in the Online Application Form. No representation in this regard will be accepted later on. No off line application forms will be accepted. The candidate is not required to upload any document in Online Application. 4. MODE OF PAYMENT:

The candidate can deposit the requisite fee through 'Online Payment Gateway' using Credit Card/Debit Card(Rupay)/ Net Banking/UPI or through 'Challan' (With Challan the candidate shall deposit fee in any branch of SBI). The information in respect of rejection of Application Forms of the candidates will be uploaded on the official website. No separate intimation in this regard will be sent by post.

7. ADMIT CARD:

Admit Card for written examination of DRIVER will be either sent by post or email. In case the Admit Card is sent by e-mail, the candidate may get its print out. The candidate is required to paste his latest photograph on the Admit Card and is required to get it attested from any Gazetted Officer. Apart from this the candidate is required to carry his photo identity proof such as Aadhar, Driving Licence etc. during examination.

8. EVALUATION OF 15 MARKS:

Intimation for inviting candidates for evaluation of 15 Marks will be sent by e- mail or by post. For evaluation, the candidates are required to bring acknowledgement receipt of Online Application Form along with original certificates and self attested photocopies of all the necessary certificates and documents.

9. CATEGORY CLAIMS:

The category once claimed by the candidate(s) will not be allowed to be changed at any stage. The SC/ S.T./ O.B.C./ WFF/ Ex- SM and PwD candidates must possess such certificates(s) in support of their claims made in the Online Application Form. The benefit of reservation will be admissible on parental basis only.

10. OTHER TERMS & CONDITIONS:

- (a) The candidates must read the instructions/other terms and conditions carefully, which are mentioned in this advertisement before filling up the Online Application Form.
- (b) The candidates are advised to give their working **mobile number and email ID** in Online Application From and ensure they are functional so that they may be contacted for any issue during the recruitment process.
- (c) The candidates must fill up their complete and correct particulars in the Online Application Form to avoid rejection of candidature. Furnishing incorrect information may invite disqualification of candidature.
- (d) Date for determining eligibility of all candidates in respect of essential qualification(s) and experience, if any, etc., shall be the prescribed closing date for submission of online application form.
- (e) Onus of proving that a candidate has acquired requisite driving licence/ essential qualification(s) by the stipulated date is on the candidate.
- (f) In service candidates may apply for the posts with information to their Head of Departments/ Employer for issuing NOC. No in service candidate will be evaluated unless he/she brings **NOC** from the concerned employer.

- (s) The candidates belonging to OBC of HP Category must produce OBC certificate(s) on the prescribed format, which should not be more than one year old at the time of last date fixed for submission of Online Application Form. The validity of the certificate is required to be seen at the time of Evaluation of 15 marks.

The benefit of reservation under EWS can be availed upon production of an Income and Asset Certificate issued by the Competent Authority i.e. DC/ADC/ADM/ SDO (Civil) of the area where the candidate and /or his family resides; and revenue officer not below the rank of Tehsildar. The validity of IRDP/BPL certificate is of six months from the date of its issuance.

The validity of the certificate is required to be seen at the time of Evaluation of 15 marks. The candidate belonging to us-reserved BPL category are not required to submit Income & Asset Certificate. They shall be treated as eligible for EWS reservation on the basis of valid BPL certificate issued by the competent authority and supplemented by the non- SC-/ST/OBC Certificate. If any BPL candidate B.P.L. certificate countersigned by the Block Development Officer and also a non-SC/ST/OBC certificate issued by the candidate must possess these certificates on prescribed formats at the time of submission of Online Application Form or by the prescribed closing date of applications.
